Brookhaven Road Paving Underway

Brookhaven, GA July 7, 2014 – The City of Brookhaven will begin resurfacing and paving projects as part of the 2014 paving schedule. The following list of streets were approved in the City’s 2014 budget, and will be either paved or repaired over the next 60 days:

1. Pamela Drive (from Tryon Road to Cravenridge)
2. Redding Road (at the Caldwell intersection)
3. Caldwell Rd (from Redding Road to the city limits)
4. Ashford Rd (from Dresden Drive to Redding Way)
5. Curtis Drive (from North Druid Hills to Buford Highway)
6. Goodwin Rd (from city limits to East Roxboro)
7. Lenox Park Blvd (from North Druid Hills to City limits)
8. Fuller Road (from Mabry to Osborne)
9. Hermance Drive (from Costco service drive to Windsor Parkway)
10. Woodrow Way (from Lanier to Windsor)
11. W Nancy Creek Drive (from Old Johnson Ferry to Ashford Dunwoody)
12. Ashford Dunwoody Road (from Harts Mill to South Johnson Ferry)
13. Dresden Drive (from Ellijay Road to Apple Valley Road)

In total, City crews will be resurfacing and repaving portions of 16 roads, equivalent to approximately six miles of roadway. Each paving project is expected to last between five and seven days, depending on weather conditions, and residents living in close proximity to road work sites will be notified via door hangers in advance of any work, but are also encouraged to subscribe to the Brookhaven’s email newsletter to receive information about any last-minute changes.
