City of Brookhaven Council Approves Amendment to City Code of Ordinances
Alcoholic pouring hours and hours of operation changed

Brookhaven, GA – In an effort to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Brookhaven, the City Council approved amendments to four sections in Chapter 4 of the Code of Ordinances, which changed the times alcohol can legally be served in bars and restaurants. The new ordinance amends alcohol pouring hours from the City of Brookhaven’s current 4:55 am closing to 3:30 am, with the prohibition of sales one-half hour before closing.

“These new earlier hours allow the entertainment and nightlife establishments in Brookhaven to remain competitive, but also help to regulate public safety,” said Mayor J. Max Davis.

“It was essential that we allowed our businesses to remain competitive and not require them to drastically change their business models,” said Councilmember Bates Mattison.

This new ordinance will takes effect on June 1, 2015.
