**City Council Passes Amendment to Zoning Ordinance**  
*Chapter 27 retrofitted*

**Brookhaven, GA** – The Brookhaven City Council recently passed an amendment to readopt Chapter 27, also known as the Zoning Ordinance. The amendment addressed retrofitting the Zoning Ordinance to best fit the needs of the City of Brookhaven. The original Ordinance was among the many ordinances adopted during municipal startup, previously established by DeKalb County. By law, the City of Brookhaven is required to adopt regulations before the city reaches two years of incorporation.

“It’s great that we went back and cleaned up the Zoning Ordinance and truly made it appropriate to the City of Brookhaven,” said Mayor J. Max Davis.
