Sign Ordinance Updated. Moratorium lifted

Brookhaven, GA – The city council passed an updated sign ordinance that includes the proper references to the newly approved zoning map. Additionally, the Mayor and Council approved other changes that included new controls on the brightness and movement of LED signs, new banner regulations to increase the permitted size to 24 sq ft, with restrictions aimed at mostly commercial signage.

The revised ordinance continues to limit the largest signs in Brookhaven to 20' by 15' , a measure that was adopted to restrict the proliferation of large billboards.

Any signs in the right-of-way or on utility poles are illegal and will continue to be removed.

The sign moratorium that was imposed so the city could make these updates has now been lifted. The entire updated sign ordinance is available online at www.brookhavenga.gov
