**Brookhaven to wrap up fall food truck series**

**Brookhaven, GA, Oct. 28, 2013** – The city will celebrate its final Food Truck Roundup event of the season on Wed., Oct 30 at Blackburn Park with a Halloween costume contest.

In addition to more than a dozen food truck options, live music, children’s tennis activities and a pet watering station, the event will feature a Halloween costume contest for children and pets. The Ashford-Dunwoody YMCA teen program will begin judging at 7:30 p.m. Winners will receive prizes.

This event series has become a popular community event for many residents since its Sept. 4 launch to celebrate Brookhaven parks. More than 2,000 people participate each week— a statistic that the city hopes will draw sponsors for a spring series.

“The food truck events foster a sense of community, which is one of the city’s goals for our parks,” Mayor J. Max Davis said. “It makes me proud to see members of council meeting residents, answering questions and neighbors meeting neighbors. This event really brings everyone together.”

Brookhaven hosts the Food Truck Roundup in conjunction with Fork in the Road, a joint venture between food truck provider Happy Belly and the Atlanta Street Food Coalition.

“It has been a pleasure working with Brookhaven on their first food truck series. We’ve heard great feedback from residents and businesses,” said Terry Hall, president of Happy Belly Truck/Fork in the Road Event Management.
