City of Brookhaven Council Votes to Defer Annexations

Children's Healthcare of Atlanta and Executive Park annexation tabled until Dec. 2

Brookhaven, GA, Nov. 24, 2014 -- In a Special Called Meeting on Monday, Nov. 24, the City of Brookhaven Council voted to defer consideration and approval of ordinances allowing Children's Healthcare of Atlanta and Executive Park annexation into City of Brookhaven city limits. This vote comes after two reads of each ordinance and public hearings.

"We want to continue the process of making sure the annexation request is thoroughly vetted before making a final decision," said Mayor J. Max Davis.

The motion to defer voting was led by Councilmember Joe Gebbia and received a second from Councilmember Bates Mattison. Both ordinances will appear on the Dec. 2 Regular Council Meeting at 7:00 p.m.

"As Council, we want to make sure we are thinking regionally about our decisions. Our deferral allows local neighborhoods to further consider possible inclusion in this annexation process," said Councilmember Joe Gebbia.
