Brookhaven Police accident reports available online

Brookhaven, GA, Oct. 24, 2013 – Brookhaven Police accident reports are now available online for purchase.

The city has partnered with the Georgia Electronic Accident Reporting System (GEARS) to make traffic incident reports available online at www.buycrash.com.

“Residents will now have 24-hour access to accident reports from home without having to drive to city hall,” Police Chief Gary Yandura said. “This is also convenient for insurance companies and out-of-town motorists involved in traffic incidents in Brookhaven.”

The city will be reimbursed \$5 for every report purchased through the site. The city is not paying for the service.

BuyCrash.com is operated by Appriss, which runs GEARS. GEARS is the sole provider of accident information to the Georgia Department of Transportation and endorsed by the Georgia Association of Chiefs of Police. Most law enforcement agencies in Georgia also use this service. The system includes software tools for law enforcement agencies to analyze crash reports.
