## **Murphey Candler-Nancy Creek stream walks continue May 29**

**Brookhaven, GA, May 27, 2015** – As part of the City of Brookhaven's Murphey Candler Lake watershed study, professionals from Sustainable Water Planning & Engineering will continue walking in and along streams and waterbodies this week.

They will be walking Nancy Creek on Friday, May 29, from Marist School to Johnson Ferry. Neighboring streets include Chelsea Crescent NE, Sunderland Ct., Duberry Ct., Wood Valley Ct. and the cul-de-sac on W. Nancy Creek Drive. They will then move to Bubbling Creek. They will walk along Danbury Parc Pl., Donaldson Dr. NE, Bubbling Creek Rd. NE, Park Creek Ln. and Ellsworth Way. The engineers will walk from the city line to the east to Harts Mill Rd. NE, including along Blackburn Park.

The city requests that residents offer their support to these professionals during this project.
