### **Public input sought for Murphey Candler Lake study**

**Brookhaven, GA, Sept. 4, 2015** – As part of the development of the City of Brookhaven's Nancy Creek Watershed Improvement Plan, professionals from Sustainable Water Planning & Engineering will host a public input meeting on Wednesday, Sept. 9.

The meeting will start at 7 p.m. at Lynwood Park Community Center.

There will be a brief presentation followed by an open house to obtain public input and to answer questions. The focus of the meeting is to collect concerns and wants from the community for the Nancy Creek watershed, including Murphey Candler Lake.

"We encourage the public to attend this meeting," Public Works Director Bennett White said. "It's important that we obtain as much input as possible for this study, which will ultimately identify a list of capital improvement projects that the city can undertake to improve conditions within the watershed, including the lake."

Engineers have previously conducted stream and lake walks and have held stakeholder meetings to gather information.

Lynwood Park is located at 3360 Osborne Road.
