## **Public meetings scheduled for Nancy Creek/Murphey Candler watershed study**

**Brookhaven, GA, Jan. 21, 2016** – As part of the City of Brookhaven’s Nancy Creek/Murphey Candler Lake watershed study, another round of public meetings will take place Wednesday, Jan. 27, and Wednesday, Feb. 3, at 7 p.m.

Each meeting will include a brief presentation of a draft list of recommended projects, followed by an opportunity for the public to share concerns or interests in the watershed.

As part of the study, engineers with Sustainable Water Planning & Engineering have conducted stream and lake walks and have held previous public and stakeholder meetings to gather information.

The study will assist the city in securing grant funds for the projects, programs and policies that are identified in the plan to improve watershed health and minimize flooding.

Both meetings are taking place at Marist School’s Ivy Street Center Lecture Hall, 3790 Ashford Dunwoody Road. To reach the meeting location, enter the campus, pass the guard gate and recreational fields. Turn right into the main parking lot. The Ivy Street Center is across Ivy Street from the parking lot.
