Community invited to Peachtree Creek Greenway open house

Brookhaven, GA, Feb. 4, 2016 – The city of Brookhaven will hold an Open House for the future Peachtree Creek Greenway at Brookhaven on Tuesday, Feb. 16, from 6 to 8 p.m. at City Hall Council Chambers, 4362 Peachtree Road. Consultants will present the draft master plan of the greenway in an informal open house format for the public to review and provide comments to be incorporated into the final master plan.

The consultants, Heath & Lineback Engineers, were selected to develop a master plan for the Peachtree Creek Greenway. The objective is to develop a framework for constructing an integrated system of multi-use and natural trails along the north fork of Peachtree Creek.

The north fork begins just outside I-285 and generally follows I-85 until it joins the south fork of Peachtree Creek near the Lindbergh MARTA station. The goal of the greenway is to provide residents with close-to-home and close-to-work access to bicycle and pedestrian trails, serve transportation and recreation needs, and help encourage quality of life and sustainable economic growth. The Peachtree Creek Greenway at Brookhaven is slated to become District 4's first park.

The open house meeting format will allow the public to review the proposed plans and interact directly with the consultants and city staff and ask questions and provide comments. There will be no formal presentations so the public can attend at their convenience at any point during the scheduled meeting time.
