The City of Brookhaven's Tree Fund was established by City Ordinance, Chapter 14, Section 14-39 (Municode version Article III, Chapter 14-47)

Authorized Receipts

Funds contributed to the City as a part of alternative compliance Once the city arborist has determined that special constraints of a site result in an inability to provide the required 120 inches per acre or 45 percent canopy coverage in preservation and/or specimen recompense inches per acre must also plant trees on the site

Authorized Expenses

1. The purchase and installation of trees in parks, right of ways and other City owned or leased property;
2. Maintenance of City trees;
3. Promotion of a healthy urban forest; and
4. The removal and replacement of a "boundary tree" pursuant to Section 14-39(h)(2)e and (Municode version 14-51 a.-f.) of the Tree Ordinance.


