Brookhaven starts sidewalk work

Brookhaven, GA Dec. 17, 2013 – Brookhaven began pouring concrete for new sidewalks today on the city's one-year anniversary.

Crews are starting in District 2 on Briarwood Way, but sidewalks will be added in each of the city's four districts. The new sidewalk will extend 1,000 feet from entrance of Briarwood Park to Drew Valley Road, improving safe pedestrian access to Briarwood Park.

In October, the mayor and council identified several locations for the construction of new sidewalks in each district.

"We are excited to improve pedestrian access and safety throughout the city, particularly on this one-year anniversary of Brookhaven becoming a city," District 2 Councilman Jim Eyre said.

Work on the Briarwood Way sidewalk is expected to last until Thursday, weather permitting. Motorists should expect a partial lane closure on this road to facilitate construction.
